Karl Girardet was born in 1976 in Switzerland. He is an offspring of an illustrious family of painters from Le Locle (Canton of Neuchâtel). He started photography as an autodidact and is now a qualified photographer.

He captures the profound atmosphere of streets and landscapes. Thanks to his experience as an illustrator and airbrush artist, he sets ablaze the colors of landscapes and of the artificial lights of the cities he visits all over the world.

Taking the shots is just the first step in his artistic approach. The creative process is followed by handling the colors, the light and the contrasts of the pictures. Finally the choice of print and of paper completes the quality of his work.
