## Location



**Bus:** Take No. 21 bus bound for *Bremgarten* from the Bern main station, get off at *Innere Enge* (the 4<sup>th</sup> bus stop) and descend Engestrasse about 100m.

**Car:** Take the *Neufeld* exit from the highway; then take the direction *Bern-Zentrum*. After the tunnel, turn right to *Tiefenaustrasse*. Turn right at the next traffic light to *Neubrücke* and drive on about 200m. Then, turn right into *Engestrasse* in the direction *Bremgarten/Rosshof* for about 300m.
