[Contract type] Kushiro City Regional Revitalization Cooperation Volunteer Lake Akan Adventure Travel Promotion Officer Recruitment Guidelines

Kushiro City is located in the east of Hokkaido, and is home to two national parks, Kushiro Marsh National Park and Akan Mashu National Park, as well as Ramsar-registered wetlands. It is blessed with world-class natural resources, such as the Japanese Crane and Lake Akan's Marimo, which are national special natural monuments, and is also a town filled with "world-class treasures," such as the UNESCO World Intangible Cultural Heritage, the Ainu Traditional Dance.

In the Lake Akan Onsen area, which is the base of operations, the Akan Tourism Association Town Development Promotion Organization, a nationally registered DMO and NPO, has been at the core of efforts to develop the town as a tourist destination, such as attracting visitors and improving the environment to welcome them, and many tourists, including foreigners, have visited the area.

In the city, which regards tourism as a leading industry in the region, it has been participating in the International Travel and Adventure Show (ATWS) since 2016, ahead of the rest of the country, in regards to adventure travel (travel consisting of two or more of the three elements of activity, nature, and intercultural experience, hereafter referred to as "AT"), which is mainly from Europe and the United States.

In September 2023, Hokkaido will host the ATWS 2023 for the first time in Asia, and as Hokkaido gains attention as an AT destination, it is becoming increasingly important to establish an AT promotion system, including the sale and operation of AT tours.

For this reason, Kushiro City is recruiting people who will promote AT in the region and convey the appeal of the Lake Akan Onsen area both domestically and internationally as Kushiro City Regional Revitalization Cooperation Team Lake Akan Adventure Travel Promoters.

We look forward to receiving applications from motivated individuals.

Commission type	 You will enter into a contract with Kushiro City and carry out your work based on this contract. Therefore, since you will not be in an employment relationship with the city, you will be required to enroll in health insurance and pensions, etc., and pay the insurance premiums, etc., yourself. Working hours per day will be 8 hours and 45 minutes (including a 1-hour break) between 9:00 and 18:00. *However, this may vary depending on the content of the work. In principle, you will work 5 days a week, and your total working hours per year will be 1,898 hours and 45 minutes (equivalent to 245 days). Regional revitalization cooperation team members will be required to submit activity reports once a month, including the content of their activities, hours, expenses, etc. You may engage in part-time work to the extent that it does not interfere with the activities of the Regional Revitalization Cooperation Team. (Notification required)
Appointment Period	 Regional Revitalization Volunteers are appointed by the Mayor, and the appointment period is from the date of appointment until March 31, 2026. For appointments in the following fiscal year and beyond, the appointment period may be renewed taking into account activity status and achievements. (For a maximum of three years from the date of initial appointment). If it is determined that an individual is not suitable to be a Regional Revitalization Volunteer, the appointment may be revoked even during the appointment period.

Transportation costs for the second selection round will be borne by the individual. *After selection, applicants will be required to sign a contract to begin activities as a Regional Revitalization Volunteer.
